Industrial Water Heater Service Technician

Essential Functions: (not intended to be all inclusive)

Provide maintenance and repair services to industrial water heaters and associated burners, pumps, motors, instrumentation, and controls at customer sites nationwide.

Qualifications:

- 2+ years of experience in servicing and troubleshooting industrial process equipment.
- Ability to disassemble, inspect, clean, and reassemble various mechanical components (burners, blowers, pumps, valves).
- Ability to perform combustion set up and analysis for natural gas fired burners in the 4 to 10 MMBTU/HR range. Many of our heaters utilize up to three 10 MMBTU/HR burners.
- Ability to recognize pump maintenance issues and maintain centrifugal pumps (lubricate and install seal kits).
- Basic welding skills for repairs when necessary.
- Ability to interpret schematics and wiring diagrams.
- Basic electrical troubleshooting and wiring skills.
- Good communication skills and the ability to work in a team atmosphere and communicate effectively with customer staff. Use of industry specific terminology is necessary.
- Basic mathematics, algebra, and formula knowledge is required.
- Strong reasoning and problem-solving skills.
- Use of a computer to locate information, communicate effectively, and file reports.
- Be detail oriented in completing checklists and reports.
- Ability to work independently.
- A valid drivers license and ability to travel nationwide often. This job will require travel most of the time.

Working Conditions/Physical Requirements:

- May be required to move items up to 60 pounds for distances of up to 10 feet.
- May be required to stand, stoop, bend, kneel and squat for extended periods of time.
- Must wear appropriate protective gear and clothing as necessary.
- Proof of COVID-19 vaccination is required.
